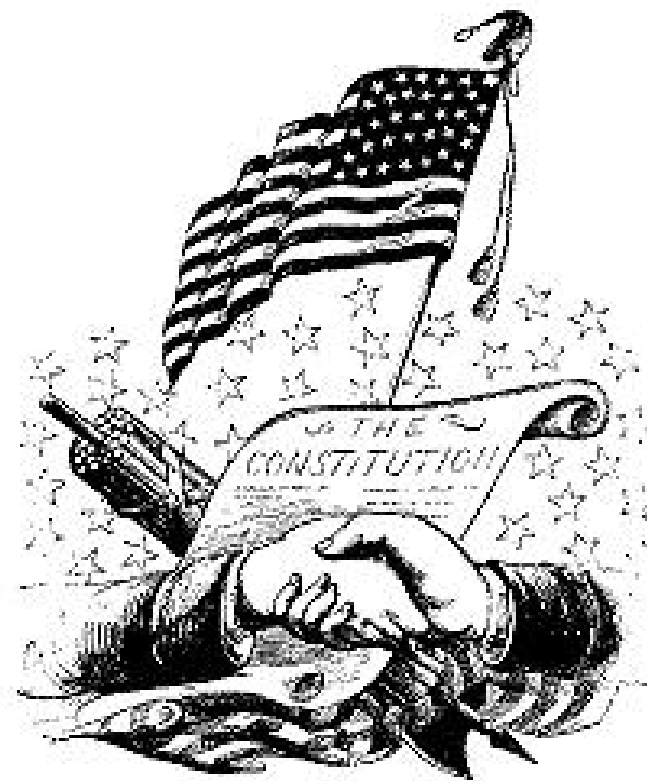
Our children leave the worship service together with Miss Dawn following the Children's Message. They will meet upstairs in the Education Building in our Tweens Room.
