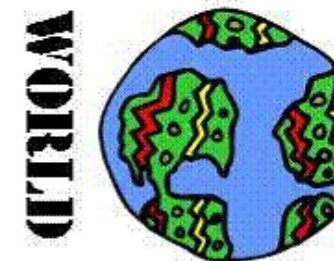

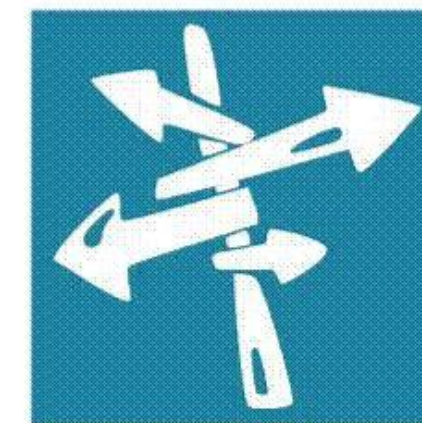

Pack-A-Sack Youth Snack Fundraiser TODAY

Enjoy a fruit and yogurt snack after service and help support our youth service project with your donation. This year we will be working with Broward County Schools and children in need. Our goal is to provide a back pack of food for children over the weekend and during holidays for those who may not otherwise have nutritional meals. We will provide for 10 children this year and refill the back packs weekly with a determined list of items. We also hope to share this mission and have other groups and churches join in adopting children for the year.

Facts:

- One in five households in Florida reported not having enough money to buy food at some points during 2009, according to a report released by the Food Research and Action Center (FRAC).
- Nearly 1.3 million Florida children rely on free or reduced-price school meals each day; many of these children and teens live in families that struggle to provide a nutritious evening meal.

ReThink Our Impact - RECYCLE CAPS

In partnership with Aveda, schools and other organizations across the nation we have collected more than 270,000 pounds of rigid plastic caps. That's an estimated 30 million caps that were prevented from entering our waterways and landfills. Based on the success of the program, Aveda has launched a new cap for some products that uses resin from the recycled caps and these new caps are 100% recycled. We are making a difference in our world.
