Did You Know...

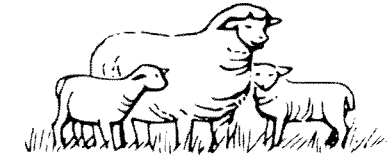

Disciple Classes Beginning

We have two Disciple Bible Study classes beginning this fall. Sign up begins in August.

Disciple I - Becoming Disciples Through Bible Study (34 wks) recognizes the human-divine nature of the Bible. The texts of Scripture were written by human beings like ourselves in their cultural settings, under the divine inspiration of God. It affirms that the canon was formed as it is in order for God to speak to us from both the Old and New Testament, emphasizing the wholeness of the Bible as the revelation of God. DISCIPLE aims at transformation, not just information, to put yourself under the power of God's Word, and to be changed by God's Word. \$35

Disciple III - Remember Who You Are (32 wks) is the connection between memory and identity as the people of God. The word You in the title is meant to be heard both in its singular form (the individual) and its plural form (the community). We are a community of memory. You will read the major and minor Old Testament prophets, with the exception of Daniel, and will read the thirteen Letters traditionally attributed to Paul. You need to have completed Disciple I to take this class.
